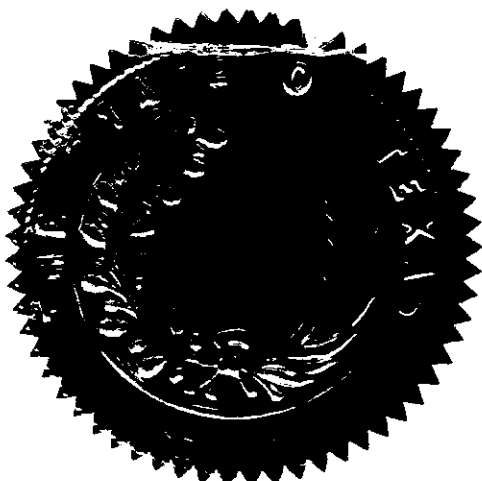

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 4.04 of the Texas Business Corporation Act, C. H. Leavell & Company adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which change its corporate name.

ARTICLE ONE. The name of the corporation is C. H. LEAVELL & COMPANY.

ARTICLE TWO. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation was adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on May 24, 1976:

Article I of the Articles of Incorporation of C. H. Leavell & Company is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The name of the corporation is THE LEAVELL COMPANY."

ARTICLE THREE. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 476,006 shares of Common Stock, par value \$1.00 per share ("Common Stock"), and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 476,006 shares of Common Stock.

ARTICLE FOUR. The holders of all of the shares of Common Stock outstanding and entitled to vote have signed a Consent in writing adopting said amendment.
