SECRETARY OF STATE

- a) The name of the corporation shall be CHANGE-R-OIL ?, INC.
- b) The period of duration is to be perpetual.
- c) The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to transact the business of a mobile lubrication and oil change service.
- d) The aggregate number of shares the corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 100 with a par value of \$1.00.
- e) All shares shall be considered founders shares and shall have no limitations.
- f) All founders shares are to be considered preferred and are to be issued to the president and founder of the corporation.
- g) No rights shall be denied shareholders.
- h) All transfer of any shares shall be by the approval of the president of the corporation who shall have all control of regulating the internal affairs of the corporation.
