

CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
MFA INCORPORATING COMPANY



The undersigned hereby certify that:

- 1. They constitute at least two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors of MFA Incorporating Company, a California corporation;
- 2. That at a meeting of said Board of Directors held at San Francisco, California, at 3:30 o'clock p.m. on December 2, 1965, the following resolution was duly adopted by the vote of at least two-thirds of said Board of Directors:

"WHEREAS it is aimed to be in the best interest of the corporation that its Articles of Incorporation be amended as hereinafter provided;

"NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that Article  $\underline{\text{One}}$  of the Articles of Incorporation of this  $\overline{\text{corporation}}$  be amended to read as follows:

"'One. The name of this corporation is: Mutual Fund Associates Incorporated.'

"FURTHER RESOLVED that Article Five of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation be amended to read as follows:
