

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, XISTERIO S. Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

THE MINIDOKA WRANGLERS, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the sixth day of April, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine, and is duly recorded on Film No. 106 of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101

and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for fifty (50) years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Rupert, in the County of Minidoka, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE MINIDOKA WRANGLERS, INC.

natural persons of full legal age and citizens of the United States, Be it known that we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under Title 30, Chapter 11, of the Idaho Code, a non-profit corporation to be known as The Minidoka Wranglers, Inc.

AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

I.

NAME: That the name of this corporation shall be The Minidoka Wranglers, Inc.

II.

PURPOSE OF INCORPORATION.

- 1. To create interest in horseback riding.
- 2. To promote events of horseback riding and to sponsor events to facilitate the purposes for which this corporation is created.
- 3. To receive, own, buy, sell, hold, convey, dispose of, mortgage, pledge and lease real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, hold, convey, transfer and mortgage any rights, privileges, franchises or interests in or to the real and personal property of this corporation; to borrow and lend money for any purposes of this corporation, and to make, execute, issue and deliver therefor notes, bonds, debentures or evidence of indebtedness of any kind whatsoever, and to secure the payment of the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, upon any and all property, real and personal, owned by this corporation.
 - 4. To sue and be sued.
- 5. To do any and all other acts as may be necessary, suitable, convenient or expedient to accomplish the purposes of this corporation, or for the protection, extension, development or benefit of this corporation, or any of its property.

LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS:

That the location and post office address of this corporation, and the place where its business is to be transacted is the City of Rupert, Idaho.

IV.

MEMBERSHIP:

That this corporation shall have no capital stock, but shall issue a membership certificate to each of its members.

V.

TERM OF EXISTENCE:

That the term of existence of this corporation shall be Fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

VI.

DIRECTORS:

That the management and control of said corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors composed of seven (7) members, to be elected annually.

VII.

FUNDS:

That this corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and no dividends shall ever be paid, and any funds received by the corporation over and above expenses of operation shall be used for the purposes for which this organization is incorporated.

VIII.

ELECTION OF PRESENT GOVERNING BOARD:

That certain persons have heretofore associated themselves together, and there now exists such association known as The Minidoka Wranglers, that such association was formed for the purpose set forth in these Articles of Incorporation; that at a regularly called meeting of the members of said association held on Wednesday, March 11, 1959, in Rupert, Idaho, an election was held at which was elected a Board of Directors of this corporation; that

a majority of the members of said association was present at said meeting and voted at said election; that notice of the time and place of holding said election was published in the Minidoka County News, a daily newspaper published in Rupert, Idaho, on Thursday, February 26, 1959, and on Thursday, March 5, 1959, and said notice was posted in the manner provided by law; that the names of the directors elected at said election are as follows: Chet Prueit, Orville Broadhead, Jack Jensen, Frank Hinrich, Don Hess, Jim Hinrich and Mardell Woody.

IX.

RESOLUTION TO INCORPORATE:

That at said meeting on the 11th day of March, 1959, a resolution was duly adopted by the members of said association there present and it was voted to proceed to incorporate said association as The Minidoka Wranglers, Inc., under Title 30, Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code, relating to the incorporation of social corporations.
