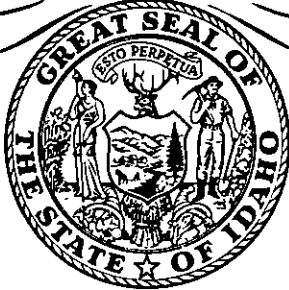

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CURRY GRAIN STORAGE, INC.

DEC 22 1911
SECRETARY OF STATE
We, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify in writing:

I.

The name of said corporation shall be "Curry Grain Storage, Inc."

II.

The purposes for which said corporation are formed are:

(1) to acquire grain storage facilities and to lease the same to individuals, partnerships, corporations, business organizations and others; to engage in the general warehousing business, both as a private and public warehouse of agricultural and other commodities, and to give bond and otherwise qualify and be licensed under the applicable laws, both State and Federal, applying to warehousemen, both public and private, to deal in farm products as broker, factor or agent of others as well as for the account of the corporation; to do a general brokerage commission, forwarding and export business; to buy, sell and deal in all kinds of commodities dealt in upon the Chicago Board of Trade and other Boards of Trade and Exchanges, to buy, sell and deal in all kinds of listed and unlisted securities on commission.

(2) To buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease, let, hold for investment or otherwise, use and operate, real estate of all kinds, improved or unimproved, and any right or interest therein. To purchase, acquire, invest in, own, hold, use, mortgage, pledge, sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, trade, deal in and deal with any and all kinds of personal property.

(3) To manufacture, produce, buy, sell, trade, and deal in any and all types and kinds of goods, machinery, products, merchandise and personal property of every class and description at wholesale or retail for and on the account of the corporation or as manufacturer, broker, factor, or agent for others.

(4) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm or corporation or other legal entity and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises, options and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, association, corporation or other legal entity either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stock, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.

(5) To purchase or acquire property, business rights or franchises or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other dis-

2 of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or
3 otherwise, shares of its own corporate stock and
4 cancel the same or any part thereof, or hold all or
5 any of such stock for resale as treasury stock, or
6 for the purpose of making stock dividends to its
7 shareholders and to restrict the transferability of
8 its outstanding shares to the extent reasonably
9 necessary to protect the rights of the corporation and
10 its shareholders in any stock purchase, contracts,
11 or options that may be made between themselves or
12 any of them.

13 (6) To act as surety or creditor in any and all
14 types of engagement, including the power to execute,
15 endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the
16 prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts,
17 notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any
18 other person, firm, partnership, or corporation,
19 and to act as accomodation co-maker or guarantor on
20 obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.

21 (7) Without in any manner limiting any of the
22 objects, purposes or powers of the corporation, the
23 business or purposes of said corporation shall be
24 from time to time to do any one or more of all of the
25 acts or things herein set forth.

26 (8) The several subdivision contained in this
27 paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both
28 purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall
29 not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the
30 general powers conferred on business corporations
31 by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which
32 powers are hereby expressly claimed.

20 The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

21 IV.

22 The registered office of said corporation in the
23 State of Idaho shall be located at Route #1, Filer, Idaho, 83328,
24 in the County of Twin Falls, and that the post office address of
25 the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho
26 is Route 1, Filer, Idaho, 83328.

27 V.

28 The amount of the capital stock of said corporation
29 shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) divided into One Hundred
30 (100) shares of a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) each
31 and that the total authorized number of shares shall be One
32 Hundred (100) shares and that their aggregate par value shall


1 be \$10,000.
