

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the Eighteenth day of February A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-five and will be duly recorded on Film-Nemicrofilm of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at in the County of Ada.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MERIDIAN PINE COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: MERIDIAN PINE COMPANY.

ARTICLE II

The pumposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, and to hold, use, operate and develop, or to sell or otherwise dispose of, timber and cut-over lands, including the minerals in such lands;
- (b) To erect, purchase or otherwise acquire, own and operate, or sell or otherwise dispose of sawmills, sash, door, blind or molding factories, box factories, woodworking plants, or other wood-product manufacturing plants, or plants for further treatment of by-products of wood-product plants; and in connection with said sawmills, factories or other plants to conduct merchandise stores, buying and selling the goods, wares and merchandise for said stores either at wholesale or retail;
- (c) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to sell or otherwise dispose of, lumber, lath, logs or shingles, sash, doors, blinds, moldings, or other wood products or the by-products of any of said manufacturing opera-

tions or otherwise, and to purchase, sell and otherwise deal in lumber or buildings materials of every kind and description selling at either wholesale or retail;

- To do a general brokerage, commission and forwarding business in lumber, wood products, and building materials of every kind and description;
- To purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease (either as lessor or as lessee), sell, exchange, subdivide, mortgage and generally operate any real or personal property of any and every kind or description, within or without the State of Idaho, necessary, suitable or useful in connection with any of the objects or purposes herein set forth;
- To construct and erect buildings or structures upon and to improve and maintain any and all real property owned, leased or held by this corporation; and to equip, improve and generally operate any and all personal property owned by this Corporation;
- To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock; provided, it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided further that the share of its own capital stock owned by it shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly;
- To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or desirable for the furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any persons, firms, corporations, associations, any state, territory, or municipality of the United States or any foreign country, government or body politic.
- (i) To acquire, and hold all or any part of the capital stock assets or good will of any business, of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in any business in whole or in part similar to that of this corporation, consistent with the objects and purposes of this corporation, and to hold, utilize and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the stock, assets, good will and rights so acquired and to conduct in any lawful manner in whole or in part any business so acquired, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of theobligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in the business so acquired.
- (j) To adopt, apply for and register, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and to use, maintain and protect and to sell, assign or grant licenses or other rights in respect of any trade marks, trade names, patents, patent rights, copyrights, inventions, formulas, processes and rights analogous thereto;
- (k) To borrow money for any purpose of this corporation, without limit as to amount, and to issue bonds, debentures, notes or other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, of this corporation for the moneys so borrowed, or in payment for property

acquired, or for any other objects or purposes of this corporation, or in connection with its business; to secure payment of such debentures, notes or other obligations by mortgages or deeds of trust or pledges or other liens upon any or all of the property of this corporation wheresoever situated.

- (1) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects, or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any person, association or other corporation and in any part of the world; and in carrying on its business and for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or purposes, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and description, to do such acts and such things and to exercise any and all such powers as a natural person could lawfully make, perform, do or exercise, provided that the same be not inconsistent with the objects or purposes of this corporation, or the statutes of the State of Idaho;
- (m) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches in the State of Idaho, or elsewhere as determined by the corporation, and to have one or more offices within or without the state of Idaho;
- (n) To buy, sell, lease, let, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, lots, houses, buildings, real property, hereditaments, appurtenances and personal property of all classes and description and wheresoever situated, and any rights and interest therein, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do and without limit as to amount;
- (o) To borrow money, to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, execute and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, and other evidences of indebtedness, and for the purpose of securing any of its obligations or contracts to convey, transfer, assign, deliver, mortgage and/or pledge all or any part of the property or assets, real or personal at any time owned or held by this corporation, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors shall authorize and as may be permitted by law;
- (p) To have and to exercise any and all powers and privileges now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations formed under the general corporation laws of said state, or under any act amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto or substituted therefor.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is P. O. Box 868, Meridian, Ada County Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The amount of the capital stock of the corporation shall be and is \$100,000.00, divided into 1,000 shares of the par value of \$100.00 each, and said stock shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI

The names and post office addresses of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed by each, are as follows:

Each of the persons above named as incorporators is a natural person, over the age of 21 years, and is a citizen of the United States of America.

ARTICLE VII

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

The number of directors of the corporation shall be as specified in the By-Laws, and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws, provided the additional directors may be elected by the directors then in office, and the directors so elected shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the stockholders and until their successors are elected and qualified.

ARTICLE IX

A voluntary sale, lease or exchange of all of the property and assets of the corporation, including its good will and its corporate franchises, may be made by the Board of Directors upon such terms and conditions as it may deem expedient and for the best interest of the corporation.

ARTICLE X

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation and no act of the corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in or are directors or of ficers of such other corporation; any director individually, or any firm of which any director may be a member, may be a party to or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firmis so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors of a majority thereof; and any director of the corporation who is also a director or officer of such other corporation, or who is so interested, may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction and may vote thereat to authorize any such contract or transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such director or officer of such corporation or not so interested.

ARTICLE XI

The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and to adopt new By-Laws,

and the corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by law, by a majority vote of the shareholders, represented in person or by proxy, at any annual meeting of the shareholders or at any meeting duly called for that purpose, except where the laws of the State of Idaho otherwise provide.
