### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, JAS. H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

#### IDAHO TERRITORIAL CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION CORPORATION

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the 4th day of October A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-seven and is duly recorded on Film No. 100 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

ten years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

Boise in the County of Ada

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

## IDAHO TERRITORIAL CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned,  
all of whom are <sup>full-age</sup> /citizens of the United States of America and  
residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily  
associated ourselves together, and do hereby and by these  
Articles of Incorporation, unite and associate ourselves to-  
gether for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation  
under the laws of the State of Idaho, Chapter 10, Title 30,  
Idaho Code, for the purposes hereinafter stated.

### I

The name of this corporation shall be "IDAHO TERRITORIAL  
CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION CORPORATION."

### II

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be  
ten (10) years.

### III

The location and post-office address of the registered  
office of this corporation shall be Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

### IV

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is  
formed shall be and are:

(1) To encourage and promote a more general understand-  
ing, knowledge, and appreciation of the history of the State  
of Idaho, and to encourage and promote a statewide observance

of the One Hundredth anniversary of the organization of the Territory of Idaho.

(2) To generally engage in, do, and perform any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform in carrying out the aims and purposes of this corporation.

(3) To receive gifts and grants of money and property of every kind, and to administer the same for the advancement of said Centennial Celebration, and to do anything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of these purposes.

(4) To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire real and personal property of all kinds, in the State of Idaho, or elsewhere, and to sell, exchange, lease, mortgage, or otherwise deal with the whole or any part of such property or rights, and generally to do anything or perform any act which will advance the cause of said Centennial Celebration and to establish a more fundamental knowledge and appreciation of the history of Idaho.

(5) To promote, encourage or conduct agricultural exhibitions, fairs, rodeos, shows, or other educational or amusement enterprises for the purpose of stimulating interest and participation in said Centennial Celebration.

(6) It is the intention of the incorporators of this Corporation that the foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the foregoing enumeration of specific objects and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation, but said corporation shall have the power to do all and everything necessary, suitable, convenient, or proper for the accomplishment of its

purpose, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects hereinabove enumerated, or incidental to the purpose and objects hereinabove named, and which is permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho, under which this corporation is organized, to the same extent and as fully as a natural person might or could do.

#### V

The governing body of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of not less than three directors, the exact number of directors to be specified by the By-Laws; the first Board shall be elected at the first meeting of the members of this corporation and successive or additional Board members shall be elected as provided by the By-Laws.

#### VI

The Board of Directors of this corporation may meet and transact the business of this corporation either at the principal place of business herein designated, or at such other place as may be designated by resolution of the Board of Directors.

#### VII

This Corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, and it shall not have or issue any capital stock, but membership shall be evidenced by membership certificates to be issued upon payment of dues. Membership in the corporation shall not entitle a person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation, in meetings of the members legally called and held within the period covered

by the membership. The rights of all members shall be equal, and the interest of no member shall be greater than that of any other member.

#### VIII

The members of this corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying the expenses, conducting the business or paying the debts of the corporation, other than the dues as herein referred to.


