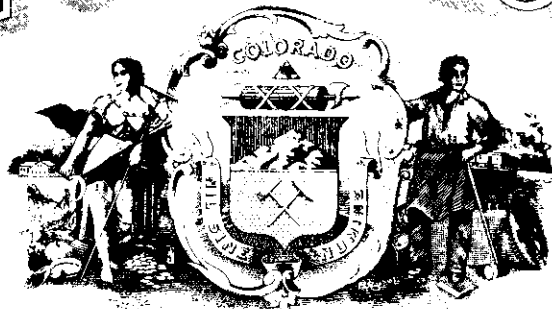

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION FOR

We the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Colorado, acting as Incorporators of a business corporation under the laws of the State of Colorado, do hereby certify that:

I.

The name of the Corporation is: E-CON-O-WASH WESTERN, INC.

II.

The nature of its business and the purposes for which the Corporation is organized are: To buy and sell goods, wares and merchandise of every description, by wholesale, or wholesale and retail, including but not limited to the buying and selling of laundry equipment, fixtures and machinery as well as to provide installation and repair service, parts and equipment; and for the performance of any and all lawful acts incident to, necessary, or desirable in furtherance of the above stated purposes.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is: 826 E. Colfax Ave, Denver, Colorado; and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is: Pat Fitzgerald

The period of said Corporation's existence is perpetual.

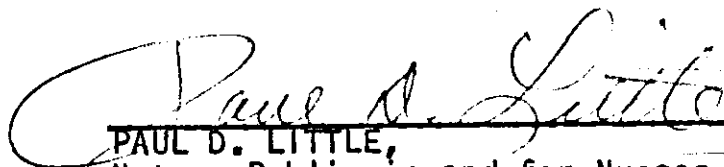

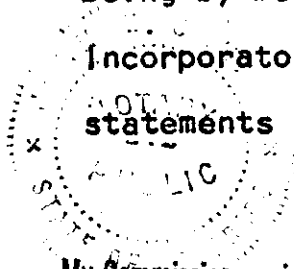


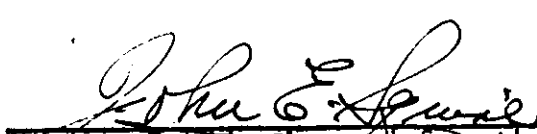
