CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP OF IDAHO, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Third** day of **July**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP OF IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, Glenn E. Barton, Donald M. Dilts and William H. Smith each residing in Ada county, Idaho, and Ruel A. Farwell residing in Canyon county, Idaho, full-age citizens of the United States, do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit religious-educational corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby certify and declare:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is:
CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP OF IDAHO, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary profit or the distribution of gains, profits or dividends to its members.

ARTICLE THREE

This corporation is formed for the following purposes:

- (a) To disseminate the Christian religion and doctrine, particularly among the children and youth of our land.
- (b) To promulgate and to promote Christian education and training as taught and exemplified by Jesus Christ and as recorded in the Holy Bible.
- (c) To conduct Bible studies and evangelistic meetings for children, to maintain necessary facilities and to conduct teacher training classes, conferences for children's workers, camps, and open-air child evangelism activities.
- (d) To produce, procure, and disseminate literature on child evangelism and kindred subjects.
- (e) To cooperate with every other Christian agency instructing children in the Word of God, and to lead children to Christ.
- (f) To acquire by purchase or otherwise, to hold, improve, sell, lease, mortgage, encumber and convey any real and personal property held by it for such purposes as may seem advisable to carry on the work of this corporation; to borrow money, and to do all other acts and things necessary to carry out the purposes of this corporation.
- (g) To receive donations of money and other property and to take and own real and personal property by gift, devise and bequest.
- (h) To do and to promote such acts and things as may be deemed necessary or advisable in carrying out the general purposes of this corporation, and which are not inconsistent with or contrary to law or the By-laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE FOUR

The principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation shall be located in the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FIVE

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE SIX

The management and control of the affairs of the corporation shall rest in and be exercised by the Directors of the corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors are as follows:

ARTICLE SEVEN

The qualification of members of this corporation, the mode of their election or appointment, and the terms of their admission to or expulsion or suspension from membership in said corporation, and such regulations as may be necessary or proper for the conduct of said corporation, shall be provided in its By-laws.

ARTICLE EIGHT

There shall be no capital stock in this corporation, but certificates or other indicia of membership may be issued to the members thereof.

ARTICLE NINE

That in the event of the dissolution of said corporation the assets of said corporation are to be distributed to the National Child Evangelism Fellowship of Grand Rapids, Michigan; that in the event of the prior dissolution of said National Child Evangelism Fellowship of Grand Rapids, Michigan, said assets are to be distributed to the International Child Evangelism Fellowship of Grand Rapids, Michigan; that, in the event of the prior dissolution of said National Child Evangelism Fellowship of Grand Rapids, Michigan, and said International Child Evangelism Fellowship of Grand Rapids, Michigan, said assets are to be distributed to Christian Schools Foundation Inc. at Caldwell, Idaho.

Public notice of the meeting to form this corporation was duly given in the Idaho Statesman of June 12, 1961; and meeting held 3p.m., June 25, 1961 at 1720 Laurel, Boise, Idaho. William H. Smith acted as secretary for this meeting. On motion of Farwell and Barton it was unanimously approved to incorporate the Child Evangelism Fellowship of Idaho.
