ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twentyone years or more, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is BUILDERS' EQUITY, INC., and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- 1. To acquire by purchase, contract of purchase or option to purchase real and personal property, including but not limited to, businesses engaged in supplying the building industry at retail or wholesale or interests in such businesses, whether the same be corporations, partnerships, joint ventures or other form of organization.
- 2. To engage solely or in conjunction with other persons, parties, partnerships or corporations in the business or businesses of supplying and servicing the building industry either at wholesale or retail.
- 3. To buy and sell notes, mortgages, contracts, choses in action, corporate securities and other commercial paper.
- 4. To loan its capital funds and earnings and to invest the same in partnerships, joint ventures, corporate stocks, bonds, debentures and other securities.

To do and perform any other lawful act for gain, whether herein expressly set forth or otherwise.

ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 5000 shares which shall be common shares and shall have a par value of \$100.00 each.

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ARTICLE IV

The corporation will not commence business until \$1,000.00 has been received by it as consideration for the issuance of its shares.

ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 87 SE First Avenue, Ontario, Oregon, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Dwight L. Johnston.

ARTICLE VI

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is three and the names and addresses of the persons who serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until their successors be elected and qualified are:
