ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ANDERSON LOGGING CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, citizens of the United States of America, of full legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the proposed corporation is Anderson Logging Co., Inc.

ARTICLE II

The nature of the business, and the objects and purposes ~~proposed to be~~ transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any and all things herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world, to wit: to engage in a general logging business, including timber, milling, and allied interests, together with the building of such railroads, logging roads, and other things necessary in the full and complete operation thereof.

To acquire, use, employ, sell and deal in all suitable means, apparatus, machinery, contrivances, equipment, and facilities for prosecuting its business.

To acquire the goodwill, rights and property, and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation; to pay for the same in cash, the stock of this company, bonds or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so purchased; to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired, and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the conduct and management of such business.

To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind, with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, body politic, county, territory, state, government or colony or dependency thereof, and without limit as to amount, to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures and other negotiable or transferable instruments and evidences of indebtedness, whether secured by mortgages or otherwise, as well as to secure the same by mortgage or otherwise, as may be permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho.

To have offices, conduct its business, and promote its objects within and without the State of Idaho, in other states, the District of Columbia, the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries, without restriction as to place or amount.

To do any or all the things set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world as principals, agents, contractors, trustees, or otherwise, and either alone or a company with others.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection therewith, whether manufacturing or otherwise, not forbidden by the Laws of the State of Idaho, and with all the powers conferred upon corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The duration and existence of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of this corporation is Naples, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The total authorized number of par value shares is 500, and the aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI
