I, the undersigned, being duly licensed to conduct a surveying business in the State of Idaho, desire to form a professional corporation pursuant to §30-1301, et. seq., for the purpose of rendering survey and engineering services, and adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: ALLEN LAND SURVEYING, P.C.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purpose for which the corporation is formed is to operate, own and conduct a land surveying and engineering business.

In connection with the above-mentioned purpose, the corporation shall have the power to invest its funds in real property and securities, to acquire, own and dispose of real

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and personal property, and to do all other acts to the extent permitted under *Idaho Code* §30-1301, et. Seq.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The post office address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Idaho is 23 North State, City of Preston, County of Franklin.

ARTICLE IV

INCORPORATOR AND REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

The corporation shall be governed by a board consisting of not less than one and no more than three directors. Directors shall be stockholders in the corporation and shall be elected by the stockholders.

CAPITALIZATION

The aggregate number of shares of stock that the corporation is authorized to issue is 10,000 shares, which shares shall be common stock having no par value. Stock shall be issued only to persons who are licensed to practice surveying in the State of Idaho.


ARTICLE VII
INITIAL CAPITAL

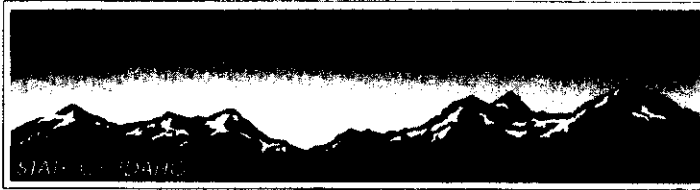
The corporation shall not begin business until the value of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in cash or equipment has been received for the issuance of shares.
