ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE LIVING WORD CHRISTIAN ACADEMY, INC.

Whereas at a duly noticed and called meeting of the members of the Living Word Christian Academy of New Meadows, Idaho, held on the 6th day of August, 1995, the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, at a meeting, a resolution was made, supported and adopted by unanimous decision to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation laws of Idaho, do hereby certify that:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be Living Word Christian Academy, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of New Meadows, Adams County.

ARTICLE III

Said corporation is organized exclusively for education and religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The object, business and purpose of the said corporation shall be as follows:

To sponsor, conduct and maintain a school for academic education on the elementary, junior high, and high school levels for the purpose of improving and developing their capabilities. For teaching of the sciences and arts on the basis of the Biblical philosophy of creation, history and destiny. To authorize the granting of appropriate diplomas in the fields of education achievement. The school shall have a regularly scheduled curriculum, a regular faculty, and a regularly enrolled student body in attendance at a place where the educational activities are regularly carried.

ARTICLE V

The street address of the Living Word Christian Academy Corporation's initial registered office is 2003 Bear Paw Court, New Meadows, Idaho and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is Helen L. Crawford.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

The corporation shall have students, parents and board members participating in the school. The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE VIII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or a corporation, contributions which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be

distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE X

The Living Word Christian Academy school admits student of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions, policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school administered programs.

ARTICLE XI

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.
