The undersigned, acting as the incorporators of a non-profit corporation organized under and pursuant to the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho Code, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is PINE TOP ESTATES OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

SECOND: The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

THIRD: The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

FOURTH: The location of the principal office of the corporation shall be in Boise County, Idaho. The physical address of the initial registered office is milepost 36.71, Idaho State Highway 21, Idaho City, Idaho 83631. The name of the initial registered agent at this address is Robert K. Soderling whose mailing address is P.O. Box 235, Idaho City, Idaho 83631.

FIFTH: The purposes for which the corporation is formed are to own, maintain, operate, repair and improve a water system for providing and delivering water for domestic household uses and irrigation of the lawns and gardens of its members. The members shall comprise the owners of each of the lots within PINE TOP ESTATES, according to the plat thereof on file and of record as Instrument No. 81964, records of the Boise County Recorder, Boise County, Idaho including Lot 8 of Block 3 even though it is exempted from the Restrictive Covenants and Conditions for the subdivision which have been recorded as Instrument No. 110822, records of the Boise County Recorder, Boise County, Idaho. The lots within PINE TOP ESTATES comprise Lots 1 through 3 of Block 1, Lots 4 through 7 of Block 2, Lots 8-through 14 of Block 3, Lots 15 through 18 of Block 4 and Lots 19 through 23 of Block 5.

The corporation is also organized for the purpose of owning, maintaining, operating, repairing and improving a system of private roadways over and across what is designated as Pine Street, Ponderosa Drive and Fir Drive on the plat of PINE TOP ESTATES for use by its members and their invitees, tenants and guests.

The right to the use of the water and the roads shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Board of Directors of the corporation. The Board of Directors shall have the authority to limit the use of water to in house domestic uses in times of scarcity or when the availability of water will not meet the then current demand.

The corporation is also organized for and shall have all powers granted by law, including, but not limited to, the power to accept donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other things of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business for profit, to exercise any power or to do any act that a corporation formed under the act, or any amendments thereto or substitute therefore, may not at that time lawfully carry on or do.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be for the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not carry on any activities which are prevented from being carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

SIXTH: No part of the net earnings or the assets of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Fifth.

SEVENTH: The corporation shall have members who shall have such rights as are provided in the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act and which are consistent with the management authority that these articles grant to the Board of Directors of the corporation. Members shall only include those persons or entities holding fee simple title to a lot in PINE TOP ESTATES including contract buyers but excluding those holding a security interest in a lot for the performance of an obligation. Each of the 23 lots comprising PINE TOP ESTATES are hereinafter collectively called the Lots or singularly called a Lot. Provided, however, a mortgagee of any priority or other security holder in actual possession of a Lot as a result of foreclosure or otherwise and any person taking title through such a mortgagee or other security holder by purchase at foreclosure sale or otherwise shall be a member.

No other person or entity shall be a member of the corporation other than Lot owners. No member of the corporation shall have any right to use water provided by the corporation on any other land other than on the member's Lot.

A member may not sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of that person's or entity's membership in the corporation other than to the person, persons or entities holding fee simple title to that member's Lot. No person shall be admitted as a member in the corporation without his or her consent. Provided, however, if the owner of a Lot does not consent to become a member in the corporation, that owner shall not be entitled to receive water from the corporation or to use the roads within PINE TOP ESTATES.

Any adjustment of the boundaries of the Lots between the Lot owners such as an owner or owners acquiring a portion of another Lot because of an encroachment or to settle a boundary dispute shall not increase the entitlement of water from the corporation to the owner whose Lots has been increased in size or decrease the entitlement of water from the corporation to the owner whose Lot has been decreased in size. New reconfigured boundaries of each Lot in such a case shall be considered a single Lot as if originally described above.

EIGHTH: All members shall have the same rights and obligations with respect to dissolution, redemption and transfer and in all other matters except in voting their membership. With respect to voting, if there is more than one owner of a Lot, then those members shall collectively have only one vote and a member owning more than one Lot shall have the number of votes equal to the number of Lots owned by that member.

MINTH: The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The number of directors serving on the Board shall be fixed in accordance with the corporation's By-Laws. Each director of the corporation shall, at all times, be a member of the corporation. Other than the directors constituting the initial Board of Directors, who are designated in these Articles, directors shall be elected by the members of the corporation in the manner and for the term provided in the By-Laws of the corporation.

The Director named above and designated as holding Director's Position No. 1 shall serve until the first annual meeting of members at which time that Director's position shall terminate. At the first annual meeting of members, the members shall elect a director to fill Director's Position No. 1. The term of office of the Director elected to Director's Position No. 1 shall thereafter be for a term of three years with the position being filled by a vote of the members at every third annual meeting of members thereafter.

The Director named above and designated as holding Director's Position No. 2 shall serve until the second annual meeting of members at which time that Director's position shall terminate. At the second annual meeting of members, the members shall elect a director to fill Director's Position No. 2. The term of office of the Director Position No. 2 shall thereafter be for a term of three years with the position being filled by a vote of the members at every third annual meeting of members thereafter.

The Director named above and designated as holding Director's Position No. 3 shall serve until the third annual meeting of members at which time that director's position shall terminate. The term of office of the director elected to Director's Position No. 3 shall thereafter be for a term of three years with the position being filled by a vote of the members at every third annual meeting of members thereafter.

A vacancy in any of the three Director's positions shall be filled by the members unless first filled by the remaining members of the board of directors.

Despite the expiration of a director's term, the director continues to serve until the director's successor is elected and qualified or until there is a decrease in the number of directors.

TENTH: The Board of Directors of the corporation shall have the authority to levy regular and special assessments on all members. The assessments per Lot shall be equal. That is, the members owning one Lot shall collectively be assessed the same amount as one member owning one Lot. A member owning more than one Lot shall be assessed an amount equal to the number of Lots owned by that member multiplied by the amount of the assessment assessed against the member owning one Lot.

The By-Laws of the corporation shall set forth the manner of fixing the amount of the assessment and the method by which the assessment is collected and may make the assessments payable at such times or intervals and upon such notice as set forth in the By-Laws. Assessments shall be enforceable by legal action or by the forfeiture of membership, or both, upon giving written notice twenty days before commencement of such action or such forfeiture. If an assessment is delinquent, the Board of Directors may, in their discretion, shut off the delivery of water or prevent the member from using the roads until the assessment is paid. However, if a membership is forfeited, the member shall no longer be permitted to use any water of the corporation or to have access on the roads as shown on the plat of PINE TOP ESTATES.

ELEVENTH: Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation consistent with the purposes of the corporation to such organization or organizations as shall at that time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended from time to time, in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes or to such organizations, as such court shall determine to be consistent with the purposes of the corporation.
