

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE TWIN LAKES
RESERVOIR & IRRIGATION CO., LT'D.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

First. That the name of said Corporation is THE TWIN LAKES RESERVOIR & IRRIGATION CO., LIMITED.

Second. That the purposes for which said Corporation is formed are to construct and maintain reservoirs on Camas Prairie, Blaine County, Idaho, and in the vicinity thereof, for the storage of water for the irrigation of lands and for domestic and other purposes; to acquire rights to the use of water; for the rental and sale of water; and to purchase, sell, convey, rent, lease, improve, and deal in real estate; and generally to do all things necessary to properly and successfully conduct and operate the same.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the town of Soldier, said Blaine County.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of its Directors shall be five, and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year, and until the election and qualification of their successors, are:

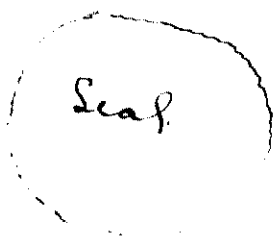
