ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SAFARI MOTOR INN, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation unite and associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, for the purposes hereinafter stated.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be SAFARI MOTOR INN, INC.

II.

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be in perpetuity.

III.

The location of the registered office and post office address of this corporation shall be 11th & Grove Streets, Boise, Idaho.

IV.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed shall be, and are:

A. To engage generally in the hotel and motel business and related business.

B. To plan, design and construct buildings for hotel and motel purposes, and to buy, sell and acquire the same; to operate, conduct and carry on the hotel and motel business, and to provide the accommodations necessary or desirable

to accomplish such purposes.

C. To conduct and carry on the business of providing meals and food for the general public and buying and selling any and all other things necessary or desirable in connection with the operation of a motel and hotel business.

D. To undertake and carry on any transaction or operation commonly undertaken or carried on by motel and hotel operators and generally to institute, enter into, assist, promote and participate in any such business or operation.

E. To perform services of every kind and nature authorized by law for any person, firm, association or corporation.

F. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and character with any person, firm, association or corporation.

G. To acquire or franchise the good will, rights and property of any person, firm, association or corporation, to pay for the same in cash, stocks, notes or bonds of this corporation or otherwise.

H. To purchase, own, lease, hold, improve, sell and convey real estate, and to construct, lease and maintain thereon such buildings or improvements as shall be necessary or proper for conducting the business of this corporation, either within or without the State of Idaho; and to buy, own, lease, improve, sell or convey such other real estate as shall be acquired by this corporation in the conduct of its business.

I. To purchase, own, hold, vote, sell or hypothecate the stocks and bonds of other corporations as well as its own stock, and to take in the name of this corporation such

stocks, bonds, mortgages, notes, deeds, conveyances, or other evidence of indebtedness, ownership, title or security as may be required by this corporation in the usual and ordinary transaction of its business.

J. To borrow money in the name of this corporation in such amount as the stockholders or directors may determine and issue as evidence thereof notes, bonds, or other evidence of indebtedness of this corporation, and to secure the payment of the same, when required, by mortgage, trust deed, pledge, assignment or other conveyance of all or any portion of its property, real or personal.

K. To edit, print, or publish any papers or circulars relative to the business of the corporation.

L. It is the intention of the incorporators of the operation that the foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the foregoing enumerated specific powers of this corporation shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation, but this corporation shall have the power to do anything suitable, necessary, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of its purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated, or incidental to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or the benefit of the corporation, and this to the same extent and as fully as a natural person might or could do.

V.

The business of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a board of directors of not less than three (3), nor more than nine (9). The board of four directors shall be elected at the first meeting of the stockholders

of the corporation, and the entire board shall be elected annually thereafter at the annual meeting of the stockholders of the corporation. The stockholders may from time to time by action of the stockholders, increase the board from four up to a maximum of nine members.

VI.

The board of directors of this corporation may meet and transact the business of this corporation either at the principal place of business of this corporation herein designated, or at such other place within or without the State of Idaho as may be designated by resolution of the board.

VII.

The corporation shall have a total authorized capital of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, divided into 1,000 shares of the par value of \$100.00 per share.
