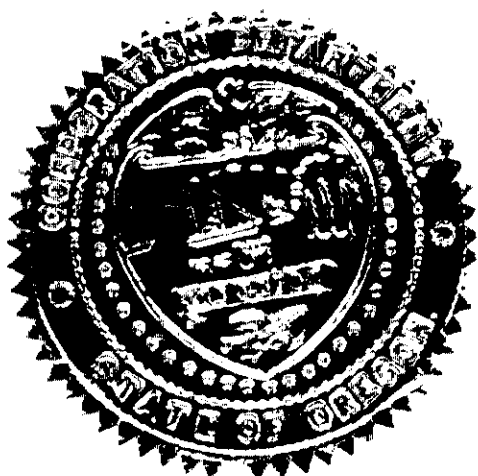

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## APPALOOSA HORSE CLUB

We, Claude J. Thompson, Faye Thompson and Ernest A. Kuck

whose names are hereunto subscribed, desiring to form a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon providing for the incorporation of any group, committee, organization or society, not organized for profit, do hereby associate ourselves together and make and execute in triplicate the following articles of incorporation, to wit:

### ARTICLE I

The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known is

## APPALOOSA HORSE CLUB

and its duration shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE II

The object, business and pursuit of this corporation is and shall be preserve, improve and standardize the strain of leopard spotted horses and mares known in the northwest as Appaloosa horses and mares; to establish and maintain proper books for registering the pedigree of Appaloosa horses and mares and to issue owners of such horses and mares, certificates of registration containing descriptive matter of pedigrees, names and other detailed data and generally to maintain a stud registration book and to do all things and to keep all records and files; to accomplish and establish, operate and perpetuate the registering of Appaloosa Horses and mares and to make rules and regulations governing the rights of members to register and to charge a small fee for registering, transferring, and for cancelling registrations in case of death, and to charge small fees for other services touching and incidental to the main business.

ARTICLE III

transferring registrations and registering Appaloosa horses and mares and the issuing of membership certificates or stock for small sums and in small amounts.
