And we hereby certify:

First: That the name of the said corporation is "THE STOCK GROWERS MERCANTILE COMPANY LIMITED"

Second. That the purpose for which it is formed is to carry on a general merchandise business in the town of Shoshone, County of Lincoln, State of Idaho.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be conducted and carried on shall be the town of Shoshone, County of Lincoln State of Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

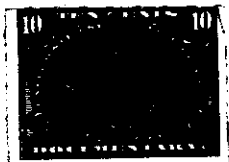
