ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GOOD INN, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, ARTHUR D. LAYTON, CARL L. VAND and DONALD L. VAND, being persons of full age, residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States desiring to form a General Business Corporation under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 1 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I

The name of the Corporation is GOOD INN, INC.

II

The nature, objects and purposes of this Corporation shall be to do any and all things hereafter set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in and out of the State, namely:

a. To own, conduct, operate, maintain, and carry on the business of a restaurant and hotel, and to own and operate hotels, and to own and operate all other things, and to do all things necessary and pertinent to said business.

b. To manage, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire and to hold, own, to sell or dispose of real estate, and to such things in connection therewith as shall be convenient, necessary or required by this corporation in the conducting of its business and at such places as the Board of Directors may determine.

c. To borrow money for its corporate purposes, and to make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, and other obligations from time to time, for the purpose of obtaining money, or for any other purpose in or about the

cash, thing or things, and shall, on payment to or receipt out of or among such shareholders, be a receipt of and of due.

4. The foregoing reservation of specific powers of the corporation shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and the management and affairs thereof, as conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, upon corporations organized under the provisions of Chapter 1 of Title 30, Idaho Code.

III

This corporation shall have a total authorized capital of Fifty Thousand and no/100 Dollars, divided into 500 shares at the par value of One Hundred and no/100 Dollars per share.

IV

Each of the stock holders of record shall be entitled at all meetings of the corporation and any other matters requiring a vote, to one vote for each share of stock standing in his name upon the books of the corporation. In voting for directors or officers the stock may be voted cumulatively.

V

The office of the corporation shall be located at Cool Chin an Elm., Boise, Idaho.

VI

The duration of the corporation is to be perpetual.

VII

The number of directors is to be not less than three or more than seven in number. The directors need not be stockholders.

VIII

The directors shall be elected by each subscriber in the
