

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION,
OF THE LONG ISLAND IRRIGATING COMPANY.

ARTICLE Ist.

This certifies that we undersigned have this 13th day of March, 1890 formed a Corporation for the purpose herein after specified, and which shall be known as the Long Island Irrigating Company, with such powers and privileges as are allowed by law.

Article II

The purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to take water from the South Fork of Snake River, in Blingham County, Idaho, and to construct the necessary Canals, and to acquire water rights, for agricultural and domestic purposes. The Head Gate of the Main Canal being located on the left bank of the South Fork of Snake River, at a point about one half mile up stream from the $2\frac{1}{2}$ mile Post of Sec 33, Tp. 5, R. E. 39, T. Boise Meridian and this Canal has been in operation nine years in Blingham County, Idaho.

Article III

The place where its principal business is to be transacted is Menan, Idaho.

Article IV.

The Corporation is to exist for a period of fifty Years.
