ARTICLE I: The name of the corporation is Moscow Band Boosters, Inc.

ARTICLE II-A: This corporation is a nonprofit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized and pursuant to all provisions under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 30, Title 30.

ARTICLE II-B: The purpose of Moscow Band Boosters, Inc. is to support the students, parents, and faculty of the music program at Moscow High School by recruiting volunteers, raising funds, and organizing events.

ARTICLE IV-A: The business entity street and mailing address of this corporation is:

ARTICLE IV-B: This corporation will have voting members. The rights and duties of the members will be as set forth in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE IV-C: The board of directors shall consist of no fewer than three (3) people. The names and addresses of the initial directors are:

ARTICLE IV-D: The name and address of the incorporator is: Cynthia Pierce-Garnett

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ARTICLE V-A: The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) In pursuance of these purposes, it shall do all thing necessary, proper, and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3).

ARTICLE V-B: No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE V-C: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes in Article 2a hereof and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

ARTICLE V-D: Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes which shall, at the time, qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
