

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FRIENDS CHURCH OF STAR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned directors of the Friends Church of Star, pursuant to a resolution of said Friends Church, duly passed at a regular meeting of said Friends Church, held in its church-house at the village of Star, County of Ada, State of Idaho, on the 6th day of April, A. D., 1912, at the hour of two o'clock, P. M., of said day, do associate ourselves together with all the members of said Friends Church of Star in the County of Ada, State of Idaho, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

I.

That the name of this corporation is "Friends Church of Star."

II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to purchase, receive, hold, sell, convey and mortgage such real or personal property as said Friends Church may require, need or use for the purposes of carrying out the religious, benevolent, charitable and other objects of said church according to the customs, rules, regulations, covenants and faith of said Friends Church; to give promissory notes, secured or unsecured, by mortgage, trust deed or other form of incumbrance, on any or all of its property, personal or real, for the purpose of raising funds to build any church or other building necessary for the use of said Friends Church, or to be used in carrying out any of the religious, benevolent

or charitable work of said church, or to purchase ground upon which such building, or buildings, may be erected, or to pay any debts existing against said Friends Church before its incorporation, or any debt it may hereafter contract in furtherance of the purposes for which it is incorporated; to incur any necessary debt or obligation, and to execute and deliver the notes or other obligations of said Friends Church therefor; to inculcate and spread the religious doctrine of said Friends Church and to encourage the growth and effusion of its principles and teachings.

III.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is at the Village of Star, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

IV.

That the term for which this corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years, from and after the date of its incorporation.

V.

That there is no capital stock, or shares of stock, to be issued by this corporation, and that it is formed entirely for religious, benevolent and charitable purposes, and not for profit.

VI.

That the number of its directors shall be three (3) and the names and residences of those who have been selected for the first year are:

VII.

That a regular meeting of said Friends Church was held at its church or meeting house in the village of Star, County of Ada, State of Idaho, on the 6th day of April, A. D., 1912, at the hour of two o'clock, P. M., of said day; that said meeting was held for the purpose of electing directors to incorporate said Friends Church and to serve as its Board of Directors, after incorporation, for the first year; that due notice of the holding of said meeting and the purposes for which it was to be held was duly given and that said meeting was attended by a majority of all the members of said Friends Church; that at said meeting an election for directors was held and there was elected as such directors for such corporation, for the first year, Arthur J. Hadley, Hugh B. Pickard and Hugh McCowan, all residing at Star, County of Ada, State of Idaho; that at said meeting a resolution was duly passed authorizing said directors, so elected, to proceed and procure the legal incorporation of said Friends Church.

VIII.

That any person who shall become a member of said Friends Church in the manner provided by its rules and regulations shall be a member of this corporation.
