

Certificate of Incorporation of The
Union Mining and Ditch Company
in Nez Perce County Idaho Territory.

Sec 1st Know all men by These pres-
ents that We John Campbell Joseph
Sivara Henry Fille, and William
Campbell, by virtue of an act con-
cerning Incorporations, passed by The
Legislative Assembly of The Territory of
Idaho, at its first session, do hereby
create, and constitute, themselves a body
politic, and corporate in fact, and in
and under the name and style of The
Union Mining and Ditch Company.

Sec 2nd The object of Said Company
is to construct a Ditch for The pur-
pose of conveying water for their
own use, on such grounds as they
now or hereafter may own, and any
surplus water over and above what
they will not have use for to sell,
commencing on the east fork of
Crooked River, about eight miles
above the Junction of Relief creek
and Crooked River, running north
to south side of Relief Creek, and

Taking the waters of South Fork of
Said Creek. Thence running same
course, and taking waters of Saice
Main Relief Creek. Thence on nor-
th side, running westerly, to the divi-
de at head waters of Wheelers
Culch on right hand fork of Dead-
wood creek. Thence northerly taking
all the waters from then to Simons
Creek inclusive, and thence to such
places as we may require it. The
same being in Nez Perce County
Territory of Idaho, and Saice Com-
pany to have the right to build
and maintain all necessary res-
ervoirs, flumes, and dams, along the
line of the Ditch, and such water as
they may see to receive pay therefor.
Said Ditch was located by us on
the 15th August, inst.

Sec 3rd The amount of the Capital
Stock of the Company, shall be
Ten Thousand Dollars, and divided
into One hundred Shares, of One
hundred dollars each. The time
of its existence, shall be Twenty
Five years.

The number of trustees shall be three viz: Joseph Dinard, Henry Filer, and William Campbell. (The Superintendent of said company shall be John Campbell). The principal place of business of said company shall be at Elk City, in said Nez Perce County, Territory of Idaho.
