ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SYRINGA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

The undersigned, Fred M. Frazier and Theodore M. McPhee, do hereby certify that they are respectively the duly elected and acting President and Assistant Secretary of Syringa Life Insurance Company, an Idaho corporation, and further declare and certify as follows:

- l. That a special meeting of the stockholders of Syringa Life Insurance Company was held for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation and Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation on the 24th day of April, 1961, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., at the Rogerson Hotel at Twin Falls, Idaho.
- 2. That at said meeting the following resolution of amendment was adopted:

"RESOLVED that Paragraph I of Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation be amended to increase the authorized capital stock of the corporation from \$500,000.00 divided into 50,000 shares of common stock of one class only, having a par value of \$10.00 per share, to \$2,500,000.00 divided into 250,000 shares of common stock of one class only, having a par value of \$10.00 per share. The shares shall be issued for a consideration of not less than \$30.00 per share. Fractional shares may be issued on a pro rata basis. share of common stock of said corporation shall have equal right in all respects and each share shall be entitled to one vote. Each share of stock shall be non-assessable. Fractional shares shall not be entitled to vote."

That a Declaration of Intention to Increase Capital Stock of said company signed by the President and in excess of two-thirds of the Board of Directors and stockholders representing in excess of three-fourths of the capital stock, together with Affidavit of the publisher of the Times News, a newspaper in Twin Falls County, the county in which said company has its principal place of business, has been filed with the Department of Insurance of

"RESOLVED that the second and third paragraphs of Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation be amended to read as follows:

Special meetings of the stockholders may be called by the Chairman of the Board of Directors, President, or in the President's absence, by the Vice-President next in line, by the Board of Directors, or by stockholders holding at least twenty per cent of the outstanding stock of the corporation.

That notice of the annual and special meetings of the stockholders shall be given in writing to all stockholders of record at least ten days prior to the date of such meeting and shall state the purpose or purposes of such meeting. No business other than that designated in the notice shall be considered except by unanimous consent of the stockholders."
