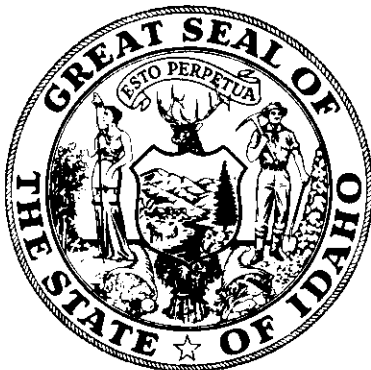

AMENDMENT OF PURPOSE CLAUSE, PART IV
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

On April 18, 1985, a special meeting of members of Stepping Stones, Inc., convened for the purpose of amending the corporate purpose as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation. The text as adopted by a unanimous vote of a quorum of corporation members present and by proxy vote to amend the Purpose Clause, Part IV, as stated in the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Stepping Stones, Inc., purpose is to insure the opportunity of disabled individuals, particularly adults of Latah County and the surrounding area, to realize their highest level of personal independence. Stepping Stones will complement and cooperate with other service agencies and will provide individualized and generalized services designed to meet the needs of disabled persons. Stepping Stones, Inc., will endeavor to protect and support the civil rights of disabled individuals.
