

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE
ZETA CHI ALPHA TRUST COMPANY.**

We, the undersigned, a majority of whom are bona fide residents and citizens of the state of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-stock, social, benevolent and fraternal corporation, under and pursuant to the laws of the state of Idaho in such case made and provided.

** I **

The name of this corporation shall be the Zeta Chi Alpha Trust Company.

** 2 **

That the objects and purposes of this corporation are to promote social intercourse among its members; to assist worthy young men to pursue courses of study in the University of Idaho, and to that end to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise real and personal property, to own and hold the same by lease or otherwise; to build, maintain and operate a suitable and appropriate fraternity house in the city of Moscow, Latah County, State of Idaho, and all such property to sell, dispose of and convey; to incur such indebtedness as shall be deemed necessary for the carrying out the purposes of this corporation; to issue and negotiate notes, bonds or other evidence of indebtedness, for the purpose of securing funds for the carrying out of the purposes, objects and aims of this corporation and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage or trust deed, or other security, upon real or personal property of this corporation, and do any or all things necessary, convenient, expedient or proper for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation.

** 3 **

That under no circumstances or conditions shall this corporation engage in any gainful business or occupation,

or declare dividends to its members under any guise or pretext whatsoever, but all funds and property of this corporation shall be devoted solely and exclusively to the benevolent, fraternal and social purposes hereinafter mentioned.

**** 4 ****

The principle office and place of business of this corporation shall be in the city of Moscow, Latah County, State of Idaho.

**** 5 ****

The term for which this corporation is to exist is for fifty (50) years.

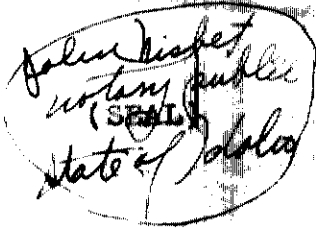
**** 6 ****

The number of directors of this corporation shall be five (5).

**** 7 ****

That prior to the execution of these Articles of Incorporation, to wit: on the 1st day of May, 1917, of the Zeta Chi Alpha Fraternity, a voluntary fraternal, benevolent, social association, in contemplation of this incorporation, held and election for directors pursuant to notice as provided by law, which notice designated the place, time, and place of holding said election and the purpose for which the same was to be held, and was published for two full weeks prior to the date of such election in the Star-Mirror, a public newspaper printed and published in the city of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho, once each week for three consecutive weeks, the first publication thereof being on the 25th day of April, 1917, and the second publication thereof being on the 2nd day of May, 1917, and the last on the 4th day of May, 1917, and further by posting a like notice for two full weeks in a conspicuous place in the building in which said election was held, to wit: in the Zeta Chi Alpha Fraternity House in the City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho.

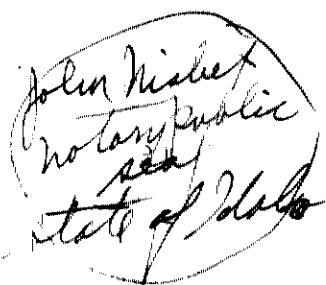
