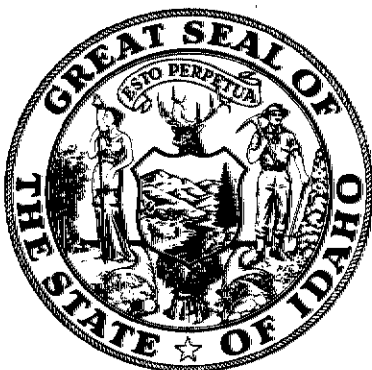

ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

OF

CANYON COUNTY HEAD START FRIENDS, INC.

We, the undersigned, being persons of full age and citizens of the United States, hereby incorporate ourselves under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, Sections 30-301, et seq., I.C.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be CANYON COUNTY HEAD START FRIENDS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation is formed as a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes of the corporation are:

- a. To accomplish those actions and perform those services as are necessary and advisable to obtain and provide adults and/or children with educational, remedial, developmental, and treatment facilities, or to acquire the funds therefor.
- b. To engage in activities characteristic of charitable and benevolent organizations, generally.
- c. To acquire and hold, develop, improve, subdivide, lease, construct, exchange, mortgage, sell, convey, finance and otherwise dispose of or deal in, real estate.
- d. To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the corporation and in connection therewith to grant collateral or other security, either alone or jointly with any other person, firm, or corporation, and to make and issue promissory notes, drafts, bonds, debentures, and

other evidences of indebtedness; and in general, to any and all things and to exercise any and all powers which now or hereafter might be lawful for a non-profit corporation to do or exercise, under and in pursuance of the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, or any other law which now or hereafter might be applicable to this corporation.

ARTICLE V

The corporation is to have but one class of members, and the corporate By-laws shall specify the qualifications, and rights of said members, and the manner of election or appointment.

ARTICLE VI

A Board of Directors of not less than three persons shall be elected by the members and shall manage the corporation. The initial directors shall be:

who shall hold office until the first annual election of directors or until such time as a successor has been named.

ARTICLE VII

The Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization except under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended; further, upon the dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, religious, scientific,

testing for public safety, literary, or education organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations.

ARTICLE VIII

The officers of said corporation, elected by the directors, shall be:

This Corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary educational purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
