ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE

STATESMAN PRINTING COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Territory of Idaho, and we certify:

FIRST,—That the name of said Corporation is the "STATESMAN PRINTING COMPANY".

SECOND,—That the purposes for which it is formed are to carry on a general printing, publishing and stationery business and to issue and publish a newspaper.

THIRD,—That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Boise City, in the County of Ada and Territory of Idaho.

FOURTH,—That the term for which it is to exist shall be fifty(50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

FIFTH,—That the number of its directors shall be five (5) and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are,
