- (1) The name of the domesticating entity is the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation), a non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wyoming.
- (2) The name and jurisdiction of the domesticating entity is the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation), a non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Wyoming.
- (3) The WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation) is a non-profit corporation with members. All rights, duties and obligations of the members in the domesticating entity will be converted into rights, duties and obligations of the domesticated entity by resolution of the domesticating entity's board of directors, in accordance with the Bylaws of the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation).
- (4) The proposed public organic record of the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation), is the domesticated entity's Articles of Incorporation, attached.
- (5) The full text of the private organic rules of the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation), is the domesticated entity's Bylaws, attached.
- (6) In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of the domesticated entity, Deb VonDeBur is designated as the registered agent of the WAFWA Species Restoration Foundation (f/k/a Western Conservation Foundation), 2700 W. Airport Way, Boise, Idaho 83705.
