ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ON

SUMMERS REALTY COMPANY

The undersigned, being qualified to incorporate a domestic corporation in the State of Idaho, hereby establishes a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act and adopts the following charter:

- 1. The name of the corporation is Summers Realty Company.
- 2. The corporation shall commence on October 1, 1982, and the period of its duration is perpetual.
- 3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are the sale, conveyance, purchase, transfer, and lease of real property.
- 4. The address of the initial registered office is 2149

 Aster Avenue, Boise, Idaho, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is James D. Summers.
- 5. The name and address of the incorporator is as follows:

 James D. Summers 2149 Aster Avenue

 Boise, Idaho 83704
- 6. The Board of Directors shall consist of one or more shareholders of the corporation, as specified in its bylaws, elected by the shareholders of the corporation.
- 7. Each director shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the corporation or until his successor shall have been duly elected and qualified.
- 8. The name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of share-holders or until his successors are elected and shall qualify are as follows:

James D. Summers 2149 Aster Avenue
Boise, Idaho 83704

- 9. The officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board of Directors shall designate from time to time.
- 10. The officers of the corporation shall be elected by the Board of Directors and shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board or until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified.
- 11. The duties and powers of the officers shall be such as are designated by the Board of Directors.
- 12. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is ten thousand (10,000) shares with a par value of one dollar (\$1.00) per share.
- 13. Shares shall be voted only by the holder of record or another shareholder of the corporation in accordance with a written proxy executed by a holder of record.
- 14. Shares of the corporation held by a deceased or retired shareholder shall be either redeemed or cancelled by the corporation or transferred to a person qualified to hold the shares within six months after the date of death or retirement. Shares shall not be transferred to qualified nonshareholders without first being offered at their fair market value to the remaining shareholders of the corporation. Shares not so redeemed or transferred within the required period of time shall be cancelled at the end of such period.

The undersigned applies to the State of Idaho, by virtue of the laws of the land, for a charter for the purposes and with the powers, etc. declared in the foregoing instrument.
