Articles of incorporation of

Poor Boy Ditch Company Inc.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more to purposes as specified in section 501(c)(12) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as the exempt organizations under section 501(c)(12) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. The specific purposes for which does corporation is organized are: *Neighbors pay fee to collect water, and then hire a "Water Master" to distribute the water. Community Irrigation Corporation that regulates the water for our neighborhood.*

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remain after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exact purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(102) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organization and, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise the attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation show not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), a political campaign on behalf of, or the opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empower to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation show not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(12) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, good to be issued to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

All references to sections of the Internal Revenue Code shall include such sections as of the date hereof and the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
