

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

ARTICLE I. This certifies that we, the undersigned, have this day formed a company for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, and which shall be known as the CLARK AND EDWARDS CANAL OR IRRIGATING CO. Limited, with such powers and privileges as are allowed by law.

ARTICLE II. The object of this company is to own, construct, enlarge and control a canal to conduct water from the Dry Bed of Snake River, now a part of the Great Feeder Canal System, in Fremont County, Idaho, the said canal being recorded with the point of diversion mentioned together with the lands to which the water to be carried, under the name of THE CLARK AND EDWARDS DITCH for agricultural, domestic or other useful purposes with such privileges of dams, headgates and other contrivances as the law allows and to buy, sell and hold water stock in other canal companies whether incorporated or not, or to dispose of or sell any such water stock as the company may possess or to buy, hold or sell such real estate as the company may need to handle in conducting its affairs as a canal company.

ARTICLE III. The principal place of business shall be Rudy, Fremont County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV. The time of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty years from the year 1901 unless sooner revoked by law or by the action of this company.

ARTICLE V. The number of the trustees of this corporation shall be five and the names and residence of those who shall manage the concerns of this Company for the first year shall be as follows,

ARTICLE VI. The capital stock of this corporation shall be FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS to be divided into 500 shares of ten dollars each which shall be assessable for the necessary expenses of the company in conducting the business for which it is incorporated.
