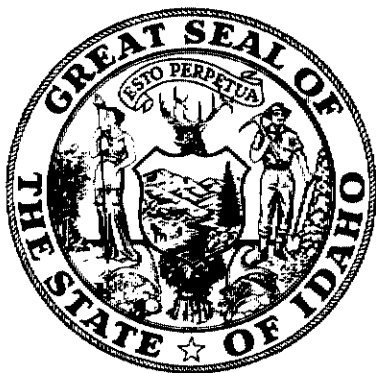

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
NORTH CENTRAL IDAHO WESTWARD HO, INC.

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE ONE
NAME AND LOCATION

The name of the corporation shall be NORTH CENTRAL IDAHO WESTWARD HO, INC. The address of its initial registered office is 3170 Neff Road, P. O. Box 2058, Orofino, Idaho 83544, and the name of the initial registered agent at that address is Paul Lineberger.

ARTICLE TWO
DURATION

The period of duration of this nonprofit corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE
PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation shall be: to promote and further outdoor equestrian activities; to represent, protect and advance the economic and educational interests of those engaged in equine production; to manage and conduct seminars, entertainments, excursions and other activities for its members and the public; to engage in other charitable and educational activities; to engage in any and all types of activities not prohibited by law to promote and foster educational, recreational, physical and social activities of its members and the public, that they may acquire knowledge and understanding of the outdoors, the natural resources and the beauty of the State of Idaho; and to enhance the economic well being of North Central Idaho through promotion of its historical, recreational, and scenic attributes.

ARTICLE FOUR
NONPROFIT CORPORATION

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit. It shall not have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or individual. In the event of dissolution, the balance, if any, of all money received by the corporation from its operations, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the corporation, shall be used and distributed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

ARTICLE FIVE
PROHIBITION AGAINST SPECIFIED ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry out any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be devoted to the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE SIX
DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall be elected by the members at the annual membership meeting in the manner set out in the Bylaws of the corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as initial directors are as follows:
