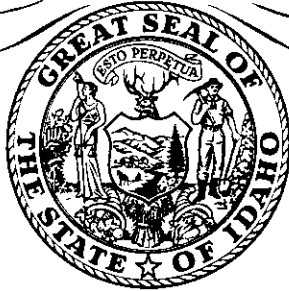

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twentieth** day of **August**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **120** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TWIN FALLS HOTEL ASSOCIATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, each of whom is a natural person of full age and resident of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States, being desirous of associating ourselves for purposes of forming a corporation, and not for pecuniary profit, under and within the provisions of Chapter 13, Title 70, Idaho Code Annotated, do hereby associate ourselves together as a corporation, and do hereby make, execute and acknowledge this, our certificate in writing, of an intention so to become a body corporate, not for pecuniary profit;

AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

ARTICLE I

The corporate name of our association shall be "TWIN FALLS HOTEL ASSOCIATION, INC."

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business shall be in Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, Idaho. The Board of Directors may provide offices elsewhere within the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this corporation shall be to foster the interests of its members and those in any way related to the hotel and motor hotel industry by common business interests; to secure

freedom from unjust and unlawful exactions; to establish and maintain uniformity and equity in the customs and usages of the Hotel and Motor Hotel Trade; to acquire, preserve, and disseminate valuable information; to stimulate fellowship and friendship among those engaged in the Hotel and Motor Hotel Industry; to do anything necessary, suitable, and proper for the achieving of these objectives, or any others which are suitable, proper, and lawful objectives of a trade association; all of which shall be consistent with the public interest as well as in the interest of this industry and trade, and as well for the protection, comfort, and convenience of the traveling public, and to exercise all rights, powers, and privileges granted non-profit cooperative associations by Title 10, Idaho Code Annotated of 1932 or as amended.

ARTICLE IV

That the number of Directors to manage the said association shall be not less than five, and not more than nine, as may be fixed by the by-laws.

ARTICLE V

The duration of this corporation shall be unlimited and perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

The Directors of said Association shall have the power, from time to time, to make such prudential by-laws as they shall deem proper to the management of the affairs of the said Association for

the government and management of its business.

ARTICLE VII

The Officers of the Association shall be elected at the Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE VIII

This corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest than any other member.
