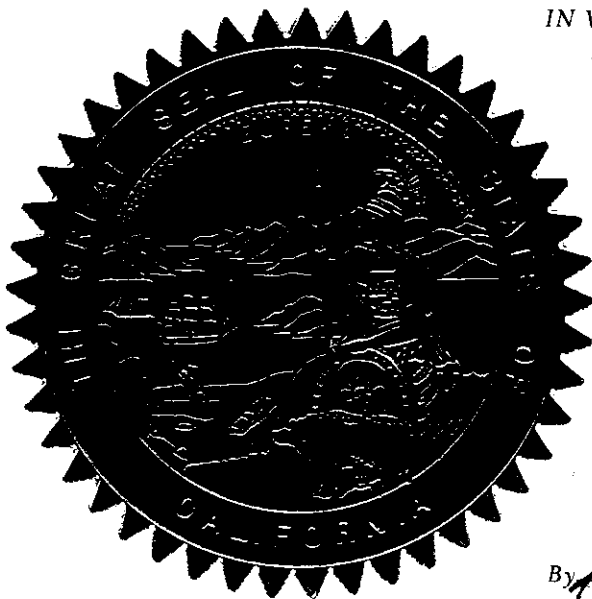

I.

The name of this corporation shall be known as the
INSTITUTE of TRUE EDUCATION, ~~A Seventh-Day Adventist~~

II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a.) The specific and primary purposes are to operate and maintain a church and the educational training endorsed by the church for its members and their children.
- (b.) The general purposes and powers are those chosen by us and which are necessary or incidental to, and in furtherance of the primary and specific purposes of the corporation. Any further purposes will be recorded in future bylaws if necessary.

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

VI.

The authorized members and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.

VII.

This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized solely for nonprofit purposes. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and religious purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Sections 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If this corporation holds any assets on trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the County in which this corporation's principal office is located, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
