5 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

6 That we, the undersigned, all being bona fide natural
7 born citizens of the United States of America, over the age of
8 twenty-one years, do, under and in pursuance of the general corp-
9 oration laws of the State of Idaho, hereby organize, constitute
10 and associate ourselves, and such other persons as may hereafter
11 become associated with us, into a body politic and corporate, and
12 to that end execute the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, and
13 we hereby set forth and declare as follows:

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16 I.

17 That the name of this corporation is, and shall be,
18 MEYER BROS., INC.

19 II.

20 In furtherance, and not in limitation of the general
21 powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, this corpora-
22 tion shall have the following objects, purposes and powers:

23 To purchase and sell farms and to engage in the business
24 of farming, and of producing, merchandising, and preserving all
25 kinds of farm and dairy products, and of planting, cultivating,
26 growing, harvesting, cleaning and assorting, packing, boxing, ship-
27 ping, buying, and selling, at wholesale and retail, all kinds of
28 farm and dairy products, and to carry on all other business inci-
29 dent thereto or connected therewith;

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32 To engage in a general livestock and ranching business,

1 both on its own account and as agents; to agist, feed, range, graze,
2 manage, herd, control, brand, care for, purchase, market, and sell
3 livestock of every kind, both on its own account and as agents
4 for other persons or corporations; to buy, sell and deal in all
5 classes and description of livestock; to buy, lease, cultivate,
6 manage, operate, and sell ranch property and products therefrom
7 both on its own account and as agents for other persons or
8 corporations.

11 farms and engage in any agricultural pursuit or undertaking.
