## ARTICLES OF INCORPORTATION

## OF 89 DEC 7 AM 8 57 BLUEMOON, INC.

- 1. The name of the corporation is Bluemoon, Inc.
- 2. The period of its duration is perpetual.
- 3. Its purpose is to transact all business not forbidden by law.
- 4. It shall have authority to issue 400 shares of stock, all of one class, without par value.
- 5. The address of its initial registered office is 116 Fourth Avenue, P.O. Box 32, Gooding, Idaho 83330. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is John C. Arkoosh, Attorney at Law.
- 6. No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation, whether or not a majority of the shares of the capital stock of such other corporation is owned by the corporation, and no act of the corporation shall be in any way affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the Directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, or are Directors of or Officers of, such other corporation and Director individually, or any firm of which a Director may be a member, may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firm as is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors; and any Director of the
