1) bold shareholder of Wypming Alaska Leasing Company, a Wyoming corporation, adopts the following Articles of Amendment for such corporation.

ARTICLF I

The name of the corporation is Wyoming Alaska Leasing Company, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The Board of Directors of the Corporation by resolution duly adopted, with the required approval of the sole shareholder of the corporation, have adopted an amendment to Article IV of the original Articles of Incorporation of the corporation, which amendment reads as follows:

> The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 500,000 shares. There shall be the following classes of shares:

- Preferred, non voting shares, par value One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per share; total shares of this class authorized to issue; forty-nine hundred (4,900).
- Common shares, non voting, par value One Dollar per share; total number shares of 2. this class authorized to issue: ninetyeight hundred (9,800).
- Common shares, voting, par value One Dollar (\$1.00) per share; total number of shares of this class authorized to issue: hundred (200).

ARTICLE III

The amendment was duly adopted by the Board of Directors and shareholders of the corporation on June 22, 1979.

ARTICLE IV

The amendment was unanimously adopted by the 26,000 shares of common stock issued and entitled to vote at the time of the presentation of the resolution.

ARTICLE V

The 26,000 shares of no par value common stock which are presently issued and outstanding to Reuel T. Call, who is the sole shareholder of the corporation, shall be redeemed by the corporation, and Reuel T. Call shall be issued stock in exchange for the redeemed stock as follows:

- Two thousand two hundred (2,200) shares of preferred, non voting stock with One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) per share par value.
- Five thousand nine hundred (5,900) shares of common, non voting stock with One Dollar per share par value.
- One hundred (100) shares of common, voting 3. stock with One Dollar (\$1.00) per share par value.

ARTICLE VI

This amendment effects a reclassification of the shares of stock in the corporation as set forth in Article II above.

ARTICLE VII

This amendment does not effect a change in the amount of stated capital of the corporation.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WYOMING ALASKA LEASING COMPANY, INC. TIME SECRETARY OF STATE

I, the undersigned natural person, being of lawful age, and acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Wyoming Business Corporation Act, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Wyoming Alaska Leasing Company, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Period of the Corporation's duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The corporation shall have unlimited power to engage in and do any lawful act concerning any or all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Wyoming Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV

The aggregate number of share which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 500,000 shares. There shall be only one class of shares which shall have no par value and each share shall have equal voting rights with the other share issued.

ARTICLE V

The corporation will not commence business until at least \$500.00 has been received by it as consideration for the issuance of shares.

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ARTICLE VI

Transfers of stock issued by the corporation shall be limited as provided by agreement of the shareholders.

ARTICLE VII

The initial registered office of this corporation shall be 213 West Birch Street, P.O. Box 216, Glenrock, Wyoming, 82637; and the intial registered agent for service of process for this corporation at that adress shall be Mark R. Stewart.

ARTICLE VIII

The initial Board of Directors of this corporation shall consist of one person, when the shares of the corporation become owned beneficially or of record by two or more persons the corporation shall elect at least two directors, and when the shares become owned beneficially or of record by three or more shareholders the corporation will elect at least three directors. The person who is to serve as director until a successor or successors are elected and qualified is: Reuel T. Call, Papworth Lane, Afton, Wyoming, 83110.

ARTICLE IX

The incorporator of Wyoming Alaska Leasing Company, Inc., is Reuel T. Call, Papworth Lane, Afton, Wyoming, 83110.
