ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be EASTERN IDAHO PREGNANCY CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is organized as a charitable nonprofit corporation organized for educational purposes for providing services, educational materials, Bible based and emergency aid free of charge to any pregnant woman who is in a state of crisis and to provide them with information and assistance concerning the alternatives available to them in their pregnancy. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be devoted to the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the laws of the State of Idaho. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member. This corporation is not empowered to engage in activities which are not in furtherance of a tax exempt purpose as provided under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the corporation shall not engage in any activities not permitted to be carried on by a 501(c)(3) organization. Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts or obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or any successor provisions of the Code or the Law, such organization to be selected by the board of directors of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The management of the corporation shall be vested in the board of directors who shall be elected by the members of the corporation as is further set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI

The post office address of the corporation's initial registered office is 202 Idaho Street, American Falls, Idaho 83211. The corporation's initial registered agent shall be Lyle Eliassen at said address.

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors constituting the corporation's initial board of directors is nine (8), whose names and addresses are:

ARTICLE VIII

At any annual meeting of the members of the corporation, the number of directors may be increased and the number of directors shall be as is thereafter established by the By-Laws of the corporation, but shall be no less than three nor no more than twelve directors in number. At any annual meeting of the members of the corporation, the directors may be divided into either Two (2) or Three (3) classes, each class to be as nearly equal in number as possible. The term of office of the directors of the first class to expire at the first annual meeting of members after their election, that of the second class to expire at the second annual meeting after their election, and that of the third class, if any, to expire at the third annual meeting after their election.

ARTICLE IX

These Articles of Incorporation shall be amended only upon the adoption of a resolution setting forth the proposed amendment by 2/3 majority vote of the board of directors and after approval thereof by a majority vote of the members having voting rights as set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation. In the event of amendments of the Articles of Incorporation, such amendment shall be registered with the State of Idaho and with the Internal Revenue Service immediately after such amendment.

ARTICLE X

This corporation, in selection of members and electing directors and in determining eligibility for any benefits, programs, educational materials or any other programs shall admit persons of any race, national origin, sex, or religion, and accord to them all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to those it serves and does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color and/or national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational materials, programs, or any other programs, policies, and assistance.
