

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

UNION CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF BURKE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That J.C. Bushnell Mrs. Minnie Bushnell, Mrs. Jennie Sweet, Mrs. Mary C. Anno, T.D. Anno Mrs. Arabelle Scott, all residents of the Town of Burke, in the County of Shoshone, State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating a charitable association, under the following articles of incorporation.

1. The name of the said corporation shall be the Union Congregational Church of Burke.

2. The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

To acquire, purchase, receive, have and hold any real-estate which it may deem necessary or expedient, in trust for the use of said association, in erecting and maintaining any and all buildings to be now used or hereafter erected upon real-estate to be acquired, for the worship of Almighty God and the furtherance of religion according to the doctrines, discipline and worship of the Congregational belief, or for the administration of charity for the bodies and souls of men, or for any other purpose that may be according to the constitution and covenants of said Church as ordained in the United States of America; and to sell grant, bargain, devise or dispose of such real-estate as it may deem necessary and expedient; to acquire, purchase, receive and hold any legacies, donations, moneys, goods and chattels in trust for the use of said association, and to erect, build, construct and maintain churches, rectories, carriage houses, school houses, hospitals, and any and all other buildings necessary and to the full use and enjoyment of the real-estate hereafter acquired as aforesaid.

3. The term for which said corporation is to exist is for the period of fifty years.

4. The number of directors of the said corporation shall be five and the names and residents of those who are elected for the first year, to wit: until 1st December 1904, are as follows:-

The verified proof of the holding of the election of the said Directors the time and place where the same was held, that a majority of the members of said association were present and voted at such election, and the result thereof, is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of these Articles of Incorporation.

6. The place where the principal business of this corporation shall be transacted shall be the City of Burke, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

deposes and says; That at a meeting of the members of The First
Congregational Church of Burke, in the Town of Burke, County of
Shoshone, State of Idaho, held at the residence of E. Sweet in the
Town of Burke, on the 1st day of Dec. A.D.1903. and participated
in by a majority of the members of said association, it was by a
unanimous vote decided and agreed to incorporate the said Congre-
gation under the laws of the State of Idaho, under the name of
the Union Congregational Church of Burke ,and to hold an election
to elect five directors of said corporation, to hold office for the
first year. The above named affiants were then duly elected as judges
of the said election, and said election of the said five directors
was then and there held, and conducted, by and in the presence of
these affiants as such judges thereof at the time and place so
appointed as aforesaid.

That a majority of the members of said association were present and voted at such election, and as a result of said election the following five named persons, residents of the Town of Burke, were duly elected directors of the said corporation, to serve for the first year, that is, to the 1st day of Dec. A.D. 1903.
