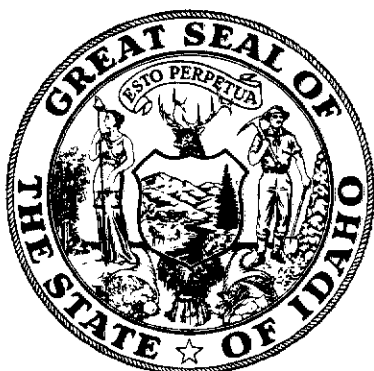

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF THE TWIN FALLS WILDLIFE FEDERATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, the undersigned, residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end do hereby certify and declare;

ARTICLE I

Sec. 1: That the name of the Corporation shall be the Twin Falls Wildlife Federation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Sec. 1: That the objects of this corporation is to aid and assist in the culture, development, propagation, distribution, preservation and protection of fish, game birds and game animals, and for that purpose to purchase, own, hold, lease both real and personal property sufficient and adequate to fully carry out the objects of the corporation, and to mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of the same, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Sec. 2: To build, erect and construct on said property so owned or otherwise held, such buildings, structures, ponds or other improvements necessary and required in the rearing,

culture and development of fish, game birds and game animals.

Sec. 3: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing, or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

Sec. 4: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or the Idaho Fish and Game Dept. None of the property shall be sold or be used for commercial use.

ARTICLE III

Sec. 1: The office and principal place of business of the Corporation is to be located in the City of Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho. The business address shall be Route 1, Box 261, Hansen, Idaho, 83334. The initial registered agent for this corporation shall be the President, Robert A. Pettygrove, at the above address.

ARTICLE IV

Sec. 1: The term for which this corporation is to exist shall be fifty years.

ARTICLE V

Sec. 1: The management and control of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of nine members, and one third of the first board shall be elected for one year; one third for two years, and one third for three years, and thereafter at each regular annual meeting, one third thereof for three years.

## ARTICLE VI

Sec. 1: This Corporation shall not have any corporate stock, but the persons composing the same shall be known as members, and entitled to membership upon the payment of such dues and under such rules and regulations as may be provided by the by-laws of the association.

Sec. 2: This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, and no dividends shall ever be paid and any funds received by the Corporation over and above expenses shall be applied to the improvement betterment and enlargement of the Association's holdings or remains as surplus.


