

RESIGNATION OF AGENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE
PROVISIONS OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Stack-Gibbs Lumber Company is a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the state of Michigan, and having filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Idaho a duly authenticated copy of its Articles of Incorporation, does hereby in pursuance of the laws of the state of Idaho make this certificate, and does hereby designate Kootenai county, in the state of Idaho as the county in which the principal place of business of said corporation in said state of Idaho is, and shall be conducted, and does hereby designate B.C. Nelson, residing at La Crosse, in said Kootenai county, as the authorized agent of said corporation in said state of Idaho upon whom process issued by authority of, or under the law of the state of Idaho may be served as provided by the Constitution and laws of said state of Idaho.

That D. H. Stetler, formerly authorized agent of said corporation in said state of Idaho, has resigned and his resignation has been accepted.

And the said Stack-Gibbs Lumber Company desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the Constitution and laws of said state, and avail itself of the rights and immunities granted by the said Constitution and laws, does hereby accept the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Idaho for all the intents and purposes contemplated by the provisions thereof relating to such acceptance by other than municipal corporations (Article XI section 7 constitution of Idaho).
