CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF BUHL, A CORPORATION

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the Thirty-first day
of March A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-five and
is duly recorded on Film No. 89 of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho,
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101
and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates
and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for
FIFTY (50 YEARS from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located
at Buhl in the County of Twin Falls ,
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30,
Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF BURL, IDAHO

BEFORE ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Ray E. Quigley, W. L. Goff, and J. L. Pomeroy, all of Burl, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, citizens of the United States, natural persons of full age, and duly elected and qualified trustees of First Christian Church of Burl, Idaho, together with other voting members of said church associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and for this purpose we do hereby certify and declare:

1. CORPORATION NAME. The name of this corporation is and shall be FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF BURL, IDAHO, A CORPORATION.

2. LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS. The location and post office address of the office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be at Burl, Idaho.

3. PURPOSES AND OBJECTS. The purposes and objects of this corporation are and shall be to glorify God and to help in the extension of His Kingdom among men for their salvation by preaching and disseminating the Christian religion as expressed in the doctrine and practice of the Disciples of Christ and the United Christian Missionary Society of the Christian Churches.

4. DURATION. This corporation shall be for the term of and shall exist for fifty (50) years.

5. MANAGEMENT. This corporation is and shall be managed by a Board of Directors known as the Church Board, which at no time shall consist of less than three nor more than thirty-five members,

all of whom shall be citizens of the United States and voting members of said corporation who have reached their twenty-first (21) birthday. Voting members of this corporation shall be persons who have reached their twenty-first (21) birthday. Said Church Board shall be composed of at least three trustees and such other officers and minister as the corporation shall by its constitution and by-laws and resolutions provide.

6. INCORPORATION. This corporation is a membership corporation without capital stock and is not organized for pecuniary profit or gain.

7. MEMBERSHIP. The trustees shall constitute a board of trustees which shall hold in trust and administer all the property of said corporation, real and personal, and shall conduct all its legal and financial business in accordance with such constitution and/or by-laws and resolutions as said corporation may adopt; and shall, together with such officers and minister as said corporation may elect as members of the Church Board, be responsible for the promotion, operation and management of said corporation in accordance with said constitution and/or by-laws and resolutions of said corporation.

The first annual meeting of the corporation shall be held on the first day of June, 1955, and subsequent annual meetings shall be held at such time as shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation. The time and place of such annual meeting, together with its purpose, including the election of trustees and other members of the Church Board, shall be made known to all voting members of said corporation by mail at least ten days prior to such meeting.

At the time of making these Articles of Incorporation three trustees have been duly elected as hereinafter set forth

and shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the corporation and until their successors are elected and have qualified. All other members of the Church Board shall be elected in such manner and for such term of office as the corporation shall by its constitution and by-laws provide. In case of a vacancy in the Church Board, the corporation shall, at the next regular meeting after such vacancy has occurred, or at a special meeting, upon proper notice to all voting members of said corporation by mail ten days prior thereto, fill such vacancy by election.

8. MEETING AND TRUSTEES. The title of the persons making these Articles of Incorporation is and shall be Trustees of First Christian Church of Buhl, Idaho; that at a meeting of said First Christian Church of Buhl, Idaho, held at 325 North Broadway, in the City of Buhl, Idaho, on the 20th day of March, 1955, called by the Chairman, notice of the time and place and purpose of which meeting was duly given by publication in the Buhl Herald, a newspaper published at Buhl, Idaho, for two weeks prior to the holding of said meeting and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held for the same length of time, the following persons, whose post office addresses are set opposite their respective names, to-wit:

S. O. Bonar, Buhl, Idaho

were duly elected as and now are trustees of First Christian Church of Buhl, Idaho, to serve as such trustees until the next annual meeting and until their successors have been elected and have qualified.

Attached hereto and forming a part hereof is the certificate of the Secretary of First Christian Church of Buhl, Idaho, who acted as Secretary at such meeting, verifying the facts hereinabove set forth respecting the election of the above named trustees.


said congregation present at said meeting, as trustees to serve until June 1, 1955 and until their successors are elected and have qualified, to-wit:
