ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

A. & B. TRANSPORTATION INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all full age citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby certify:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be A. & B. Transportation Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

(a) To engage in general logging and transportation of lumber, poles, timber, kiln drying, milling, construction materials, and merchandise business; to manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, sell, or otherwise dispose of logs, lumber, wood products in a processed or unprocessed state, and by-products of wood or of said manufacturing operations, and building and construction supplies and merchandise, either at wholesale or retail, and general trucking business.

(b) To exercise generally the powers customarily exercised by business corporations and particularly the powers provided by the laws of the State of Idaho, referring especially to Section 30-114 Idaho Code, in any State of the United States and throughout the world.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and Post Office Address of the registered office in this State and principal place of business, shall be St. Maries, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Two hundred Thousand and no/100 (\$200,000.00) Dollars, divided into Two thousand (2000) shares of the common stock of a par value of One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars each.

ARTICLE VI.




