

Articles of Incorporation
Of the
Wallace Town Site Company.

We, ^{Albert Allen}
W. E. ~~Allen~~ ^{Allen} of the Territory of Idaho
W. R. Wallace of the Territory of Idaho and
Richard Lockett of the Territory of Montana,
all Citizens of the United States, do hereby associate
ourselves together and form a Corporation under
the laws of the Territory of Idaho, and we
do hereby adopt and certify the following
Articles of Incorporation.

Article II. Name.

The name of this Corporation is and
shall be the Wallace Town Site Company.

Article III. Objects.

The objects and purposes for which
this Corporation is formed are as follows:
To purchase, receive, hold, grant, bargain, sell
dispose of, convey, and deal in, lands, ten-
ements, town lots, and other property in the

Trusty of Idaho: to explore, locate and improve lands and town sites in said Trust, and to plat, dedicate and deal in the same, and to buy and sell such lands, town lots, town sites and other property; to construct and maintain houses and other buildings, and to purchase and sell the same; to engage in all kinds of Manufacture, Trade and Trade; to construct and maintain water ditches, flumes and aqueducts and carry water through the same; to construct and maintain water works and gas works and to use and operate the same, to construct and operate wagon roads and tramways, and generally to do any and all things which may be proper or necessary to fully perform and carry out the objects and purposes above stated, and also among other things to purchase the eighty acres of land entered by Walter Beneta in the United States Land Office at Coeur d'Alene City, Idaho, on June 5th 1886 of which the Register and Receiver certify with the Surveyor field

Notes is filed for record in the office of the
County Recorder of Shoshone County Idaho
(being the County in which said lands are situated)
June 15. 1886. at 4 o'clock PM. recorded in Book
"H." Miscellaneous records at page 113. and
upon which is situated the present town of
"Malheur". and to layout and plat and locate
therein a town site, and to sell and dispose of
or in any manner deal in and buy and
sell town lots therein and all other of said
lands and do any and all things relative
to said land and town lots which may
by this Corporation be deemed proper or ex-
pedient to enable this Corporation to buy,
sell, deal in and render the same profitable,
and generally to do any and all things
 requisite to fully perform and carry out
the above and foregoing business and
purposes.

Article III Capital Stock.

The Capital Stock of this Corporation shall
be sixty thousand Dollars divided into

Six thousand shares. of which each share shall represent ten dollars (\$1000) of the said Capital stock.

Article IIIII Trustee

Sec 1. The Corporate powers of this Corporation shall be exercised by a Board of three Trustees, who shall be stock holders in the Corporation, and a majority of whom shall be citizens of the United States and residents of the Territory of Idaho.

Sec 2. Richard Locky of the Territory of Montana, and W.C. Wallau and Albert Allen residents of the Territory of Idaho, are hereby designated as the Trustees who will exercise the Corporate Powers and manage the concerns of this Corporation for the first three months of its existence.

Article IV. Duration

The duration of this Corporation shall be fifty years.

Article VII Place of business.

The principal place of business of this Corporation shall be at the Town of Wallace in the County of Shoshone in the Territory of Idaho.
