ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
MOUNTAIN STATES TUMOR INSTITUTE, INC.

We, the undersigned, Rt. Rev. Norman L. Foote, President, and Barbara Croghan, Assistant Secretary of Mountain States Tumor Institute, Inc., do hereby certify in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-147, Idaho Code, that the following are Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of Mountain States Tumor Institute.

I

Paragraph (7) of Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation of Mountain States Tumor Institute, Inc., shall be amended to read as follows:

"All of the properties and assets of this corporation shall be, and are, irrevocably dedicated to charitable, scientific and educational purposes and no part of the monies, properties or assets of this corporation, upon dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of any private person or individual or any member of this corporation, except as such member may be a corporation organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes, the principal functions of which are the providing of hospital or medical care, or medical research, and which is exempt from taxation, and particularly the Federal Income Tax. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions

to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

## II

There shall be added to Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation of Mountain States Tumor Institute, Inc. an additional paragraph which shall follow paragraph (7) and which shall be known as paragraph (7a), the same to read as follows:

"(7a) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, ~~educational~~, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."
