

Know all men by these presents
 That We, the undersigned
 have this day associated ourselves
 together for the purpose of
 incorporating under the laws of
 Idaho Territory, a Corporation to
 be known by the corporate name
 of Hailey Gold Belt and
 Western Railway Company

That the purpose for
 which this Corporation is formed
 is to construct, operate and
 maintain a Railroad in the
 Territory of Idaho, Commencing
 at a point on the Hood River
 branch of the Oregon Short Line
 Railway near the town of Hailey
 and running thence by way
 of Croys Gulch to what is known
 as the Camas Number Two Mine
 and what is known as the Gold
 Belt. About fourteen miles in
 a westerly direction from the
 Town of Hailey, the estimated
 length of said Railroad being
 fourteen miles, and to the end
 and purposes aforesaid

To acquire by purchase, gift or
 otherwise, Real Estate and Right
 of way, and to receive, hold, take
 and convey by deed or otherwise

as a Natural person such
Voluntary grants and donations
of Real Estate or other property
which may be made to said
Corporation, to aid in the
Construction, Maintenance, and
operation of said Railroad, to
Cause such examination and
surveys to be made as may be
necessary for the selection of the
most advantageous route for said
Railroad, subject to such changes
of route as shall be deemed necessary
and proper. To carry persons
and property and receive tolls
or compensation therefor, and to
regulate the time and manner in
which passengers and property
shall be transported, and the tolls
and compensation therefor, within
the limits prescribed by law
and subject to alteration, change
or amendment by the Legislative
Assembly, and to erect and maintain
all necessary and convenient
buildings, Depots, fixtures and
Machinery for the accommodation
and use of their passengers freight
and business, and generally to do
and transact all and every kind

and manner of business usually done and transacted by Railroad Companies in and about the Construction, operation and Maintenance of Railroads inclusive of the right to condemn lands and other property under the laws of Idaho Territory -

That the place where the principal business of said Corporation is to be transacted is the Town of Hailey Alturas County Idaho Territory

The term for which said Corporation is to exist is fifty years

The number of the directors or trustees of said Corporation who shall transact its business for the first year is five - and their names and places of residence are as follows, to wit:
