KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the members of the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, a religious organization and society of Orofino, County of Clearwater, State of Idaho, the majority of the members of which said organization or society are bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, and which said OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, is an organization or society associated and banded together for religious and charitable purposes, and not in any manner for profit, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves, and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation, unite and associate curselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the terms and provisions of Chapter 11 of Title 29, Idaho Code Annotated of 1932, and amendments thereto, and set forth such articles as follows, to-wit:

FIRST

The name of this corporation shall be OROFINO TABER-NACLE, INCORPORATED.

SECOND

The time for which this corporation is organized is perpetual.

THIRD

The principal office for this corporation and the place where the business of this corporation shall be transacted shall be, and is, designated at the city of Orofino, County of Clearwater, State of Idaho.

FOURTH

The purpose of this corporation thus formed is as follows, to-wit: To teach, promote, spread, carry out, and introduce to any and all people the doctrines of Christianity as set forth in the Holy Bible, and as said rites are set forth in the tenets of the OROFINO TABER-NACLE; promote the christian faith and exercise the principals of Christianity, including the teaching of the Holy Bible; carrying out of and extending of charty to the poor and unfortunate; provided for the carrying of the teachings of the

Church to all people, and in all ways, manner and form to spread the gospel of Christianity and to ordain ministers as by the by-laws of the Church provided; and for the acquiring of real and personal property in the name of the corporation for the carrying out and furtherance of any, each, and all of the purposes herein stated, or as set forth by or in the tenets and by-laws of the ORO-FINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, and do all things necessary and proper to carry on, promote, and accomplish the purposes and intent thereof.

FIFTH

The business of the corporation shall be carried on and conducted by a Board of Trustees, consisting of five members. The members of the Board of Trustees shall be elected annually from the membership of the OROFINO TABER-NACLE, INCORPORATED, at the annual meeting to be held on the last Monday of September of each and every year.

SIXTH

That the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, of Orofino. Clearwater County, Idaho, at a meeting held on the 26th. day of April, 1944, at which a majority of the members of the said Church were present and voted, and after publication of notice of holding such meeting, duly and regularly published in the Clearwater Tribune, a legal newspaper of general circulation, printed and published weekly at Orofino, Clearwater County, Idaho, in the issues of April 6, 13, 20, 1944, as evidence by the Affidavit of Posting, attached to the original hereof, and marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof by reference; and by the posting of a notice on the front door of the building wherein the members of the said OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, hold their meetings and which notice was posted on or about the 5th. day of April, 1944, and remained so posted and which said notice, together with an Affidavit of Posting, is attached hereto and maked "Exhibit B", and made a part hereof by reference; the members of the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED present, elected the following to serve as trustees until the next annual meeting:

Daniel C. Bonner, Chairman; Alice Orr, Frances Logan, Lydia M. Smith, and Howard Bonner, all of whose addresses are Orofino, Idaho.

SEVENTH

That no capital stock shall be issued. That acceptance to membership in the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, of Orofino, Idaho, shall be and constitutes membership in this corporation and the acceptance and placing of any person upon the Rolls of said Church, shall be proof of membership, and the right of vote and hold office in this corporation. Membership in this corporation is without money value and is not transferrable or assignable. Suspension from the OROFINO TABERNACLE according to the rules and by-laws thereof cancels the membership in the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, of Orofino, Idaho, and a membership in the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED shall and does constitute one share in this corporation and such share shall and does carry the right of one vote at any and all corporate meetings, and the roster of membership of the OROFINO TABERNACLE, INCORPORATED, of Orofino, Idaho, shall at all/times be the official register of shares herein.

That the annual meeting for the election of officers/shall be held at Orofino, Idaho, on the last Monday of September of each year, commencing with September 25, 1944 and annually thereafter. Two weeks notice of such meeting shall be given each year. Said Board of Trustees shall, from their number, choose a chairman, a secretary-treasurer and other officers as by the by-laws required.
