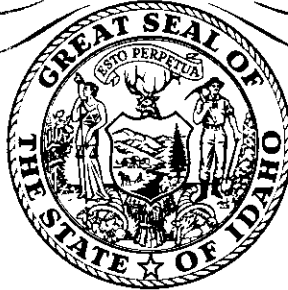

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Ninth** day
of **March,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and
is duly recorded on Film No. **119** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State
of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and
Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for
perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at
Pocatello in the County of **Bannock**
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Coopera-
tive Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE NEWMAN GUILD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho, and being of lawful age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a cooperative corporation for religious, social and benevolent purposes, under and pursuant to the terms of Chapter 10, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify as follows:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be "The Newman Guild, Inc.

II

That this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

III

That the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

(a) To promote, conduct, provide, maintain and carry on any and all kinds of activities designed to cooperate in the promotion of the Newman Club program, and to promote the propagation of Christian doctrine, action and attitudes for Catholic youth; to provide scholarship aid; to provide public relations; to aid and assist the chaplains of the Newman Foundation.

(b) To buy, sell, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, and to own, hold and maintain real and personal property, and to lease, sell, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the same, and for this purpose to negotiate contracts, mortgages, loans or any other legal contracts with any person, firm, corporation or any branch of the Federal, State or Municipal government for the purpose of encouraging the purposes of this corporation, but not for profit; and further to incur indebtedness without limit, and to enter into, make and perform contracts of every sort and kind

with any person, association or corporation, and to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount and execute checks, promissory notes, bills of exchange and other instruments in accordance with the by-laws of the corporation.

(c) To establish a cooperative bookstore to provide students at Idaho State College with religious books and other religious items.

(d) To arrange, promote and sponsor entertainment for students at Idaho State College.

(e) To publish annual year books and other literature to promote the general purposes and welfare of the corporation and its members.

(f) To establish standing and temporary committees with such powers as the Board of Directors or the By-laws shall fix and provide from time to time.

(g) To in general perform all functions and have all powers provided by Chapter 10, Title 30 of the Idaho Code as amended, and to perform all acts that are so essential, proper and expedient to accomplish its stated purposes.

IV

The corporation shall have succession by its corporate name perpetually, and the rights, interests and privileges of all members shall be equal and no member can acquire a greater interest therein than any other member, that said corporation shall issue membership cards or certificates to such member from time to time in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation, and the same shall not be transferable.

V

The location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be c/o Idaho State College, in the City of Moscow, Blaine County, Idaho.

The business of the corporation shall be conducted and managed by the Board of Directors of said Corporation consisting of not less than three nor more than five persons who shall be elected by the majority vote of the members in good standing of said corporation. The Board of Directors shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, or immediate Past-President who is elected at large, and such other Directors at large as may from time to time be elected by the members by amendment of the By-Laws of the Corporation. The Newman Club Chaplains or Chaplains shall act as the spiritual advisor or advisors, and counselors to the Newman Guild.
