ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

United States and of the State of Idaho, and being of lawful age, do hereby associate ourselves cogether for the purpose of forming a cooperative composation for religious, social and benevolent purposes, under and pursuant do the terms of Chapter 10, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify as follows:

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That the name of this corporation shall be "The Newman Guild, Car.

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That this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

III

That the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- any and all kinds of activities designed to cooperate in the promotion of the Newman Club progress, and to promote the propagation of Christian doctrine, action and attitudes for Catholic youth; to provide scholarship aid; to provide public relations; to aid and assist the chaplains of the Newman Poundation.
